No place or date is given but the dwelling house mentioned in this inventory, was at "Elm Brook Meadow [Concord, Mass.]." This inventory occupies the lower half of a page and the preceding entry is dated 1681." "Therefore we can say it was entered after 1681, possibly, several years after that date."
